

RIGHT OF WITHDRAWAL

THE APP ACADEMY / CODING ON THE BEACH

If you are a private customer (consumer)¹ you have a reflection period (right of withdrawal) of fourteen days. This period starts the day after we have confirmed your enrolment (course agreement) by post or by email. To exercise the right of withdrawal you must inform us prior to the end of the withdrawal period of your decision to withdraw from the course agreement by means of a clear statement by post, email or fax. You may do so without stating any reasons. You may use the sample withdrawal form, although this is not required. The sample form can be obtained from The App Academy and/or can be downloaded via <https://codingonthebeach.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/10/Model-withdrawal-form-The-App-Academy.pdf>.

If you withdraw from the course agreement, all payments that we have received from you will be reimbursed by us as soon as possible but at the latest within fourteen days from the date on which we received your notification of withdrawal from our agreement. For the reimbursement The App Academy will use the same method of payment, which you used for the original transaction, unless something different is explicitly agreed with you.

Note: if the course agreement entered into force fourteen days or less before the starting date of the Bootcamp and the Bootcamp started within the 14 day withdrawal period you have agreed to pay an appropriate fee that corresponds to the part consumed until the notification of withdrawal was issued. This fee shall remain due. By signing our course agreement you have agreed to the direct delivery of our services.
